## COURSE GOALS

We will review the two writing tasks, introduce effective test-day strategies, and bring your writing to the next level.

In this course, we will:

- 1. Practice analyzing various Integrated and Academic Discussion writing tasks
- 2. Receive lots of independent feedback and advice to improve your writing
- 3. Take the next steps to make your writing more flexible and more natural
- 4. Write a variety of essays in response to some advanced TOEFL prompts

### ADDITIONAL POINTS

#### This class requires participation.

You will be asked to participate in brainstorming sessions, and even to write parts of essays (and sometimes full responses) in the class.

#### Submit essays via the Writing Management System (WMS)

You will submit four essays via the WMS. They will be edited and graded by a native grader, along with some comments about points that can be improved. In addition, you will complete eight in-class essays.

#### Go beyond the template!

Templates can be helpful to get to mid-level scores. To reach these higher scores, we need to be more flexible, confident writers. We will practice that in this course.
